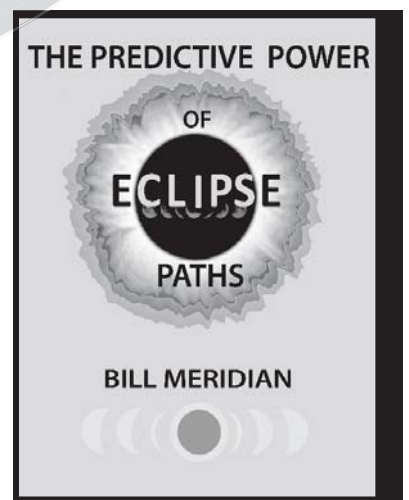

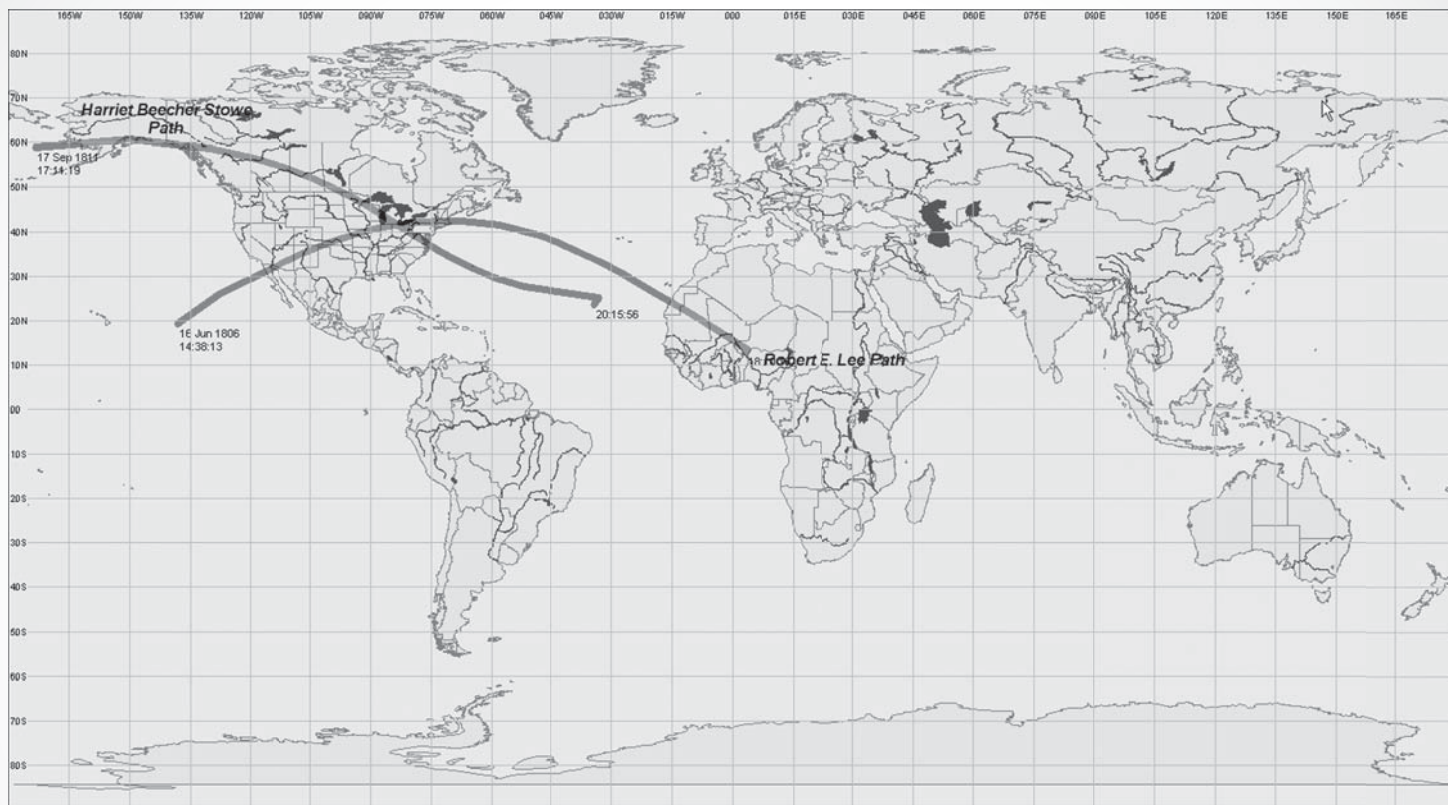

## FROM CHAPTER 4 OF THE PRODICTIVE POWER OF ECLIPSE PATHS:

In chart 4-9, we see the eclipse path of Robert E. Lee, commander of the Confederate forces during the Civil War. He was born on January 19, 1807, and Emerson associated his birth with the eclipse of June 16, 1806. Note that this path approximately cuts America in half as did the War. The Lee path runs directly over Boston, the center of the abolitionist movement. Also note that the path connects the US and Africa, and slavery was the issue. The western end of the path darkens Texas and Mexico. Many other Civil War generals have natal eclipse paths in Mexico. These men did their initial soldiering in the Mexican-American wars as did Lee.

Chart 4-9



In chart 4-9, the eclipse path connected to the birth of Harriet Beecher Stowe is depicted (born June 14, 1811 from Lois Rodden's database). This eclipse fell on September 17, 1811. Her publication of Uncle Tom's Cabin had so great an influence on the abolitionist movement that when President Lincoln met her, he said, "*So this is the little lady who made the big war.*" Her path cuts through the northeast US where her writing had its greatest impact. The path was very close to Richmond, the Confederate capitol.

In chart 4-9, the Lee and Stowe eclipse paths are superimposed on the same map. Emerson wrote that they intersect near Appomattox, Virginia, where Lee surrendered the Confederate Army to General Grant, but this is not the case when utilizing modern software. This shows the intersection was actually in Ohio.

Jayne wrote that an eclipse at the conclusion of a war frequently described the area of conflict in the future. The path of the October 19, 1865 solar eclipse also cut the USA in half and connected to Africa. This described the issues of integration and race relations that were to follow.
